That’s the slogan for Big Al Brewing. This band of local home brewers is living the dream of brewing good beer and sharing it with the local community. Wouldn’t the world be a better place if everyone was having more fun?

Big Al Brewing opens the doors with two beers. Abbey Wheat, the flagship beer which is a hybrid Belgian style/Wheat beer. It blends the smoothness and refreshing pop of a wheat beer, with the pleasant fruit and spice characteristics of Belgian ale. The second beer offered is an Irish Red. This beer is a sweet, roasty, caramel love fest. They believe in coloring outside the lines and brewing traditional styles untraditionally while creating unique variations, Big Al style.

In addition to the great beer, the tasting room offers an upstairs lounge area where people can relax, play games, hangout or gather for meetings. There is also an outside seating area where you can have a pint and relax with your dog.

Alejandro (Big Al Brewing’s head brewer) has been brewing on a smaller scale for the past decade and decided to chase the dream when Pacific Rim in White Center came up for sale early this spring. Alejandro says, “This system is like an overgrown homebrew system. For many professional brewers its old, it’s manual and would seem inadequate. For us it’s perfect. It’s the true essence of craft.”

It’s a priority to keep the spirit of home brewing alive, so they’ve created a tap specifically dedicated to the home brewing community called local hero. Local hero is about celebrating the innovation, spirit and craft of our local home brewer. They plan to reward those who inspire them by inviting home brewers to brew their recipes together on the big system and tap the collaboration beer in our tasting room. Hobbies, passions, dreams. Everything starts somewhere with something you want to spend your free time doing. It involves learning, creating, sharing, and meeting people who share the same interests.
